The Tunnel to Towers Homeless Veteran Program assists veterans and their families across the nation, no matter their location.

Our National Case Management Network currently provides housing assistance and access to necessary supportive services in nearly every state.

Our team has built a national network of nearly 1,000 public and private organizations, VA agents, attorneys, landlords, mental health counselors, financial counselors, and large-scale employers.

This rapidly growing network allows our team to be able to address each veteran's specific issues, to ensure they can sustain their new housing accommodations while working towards achieving their long-term objectives.

Our Program's goal is to help homeless veterans reintegrate into their community, as well as provide veterans who are at-risk of becoming homeless with the support they need to not backslide into homelessness.

Veterans Village FAQs:

Frequently Asked Questions

Veterans Villages are a long-term supportive housing program designed for veterans experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness. Veterans who enter the program can stay indefinitely while receiving comprehensive free supportive services.



What services are provided to program participants?

- Case management
- Therapy and mental health support
- Peer specialist assistance
- Employment, education, and entitlement support
- The Tunnel to Towers Foundation also connects with local organizations to organize other experiences on campus, such as wellness and leisure groups, that make a house a home.

What is Long-term Supportive Housing?

- *Long-term Supportive Housing provides potentially permanent, stable, and affordable housing paired with supportive services to help individuals transition out of homelessness and maintain independence. As Long-term Supportive Housing is permanent housing, there is no set time limit as long as the program requirements are continually met. Participants can leave whenever they feel ready to, provided that they provide a month's notice to staff.*

Do the Veterans pay rent?

- *Yes, Veterans pay a monthly program fee that is always lower than the affordable housing guidelines of that area. The Program Fee includes all utilities—such as electricity, water, gas, and internet—as well as access to a comprehensive range of supportive services. These services are built into the monthly fee at no additional cost and are designed to support each resident's stability and growth. They may include case management, behavioral health support, employment and entitlement assistance, peer support, transportation services, and access to on-site community activities.*

Are utilities included in the Program Fee?

- *Yes, utilities are included in the program fee.*

What amenities are included in the Program Fee?

- *The Veterans Villages include:*
 - Laundry rooms
 - Dining area
 - Fitness center
 - Game Rooms
 - Multipurpose Room

The Tunnel to Towers Foundation is currently under contract for a 5-acre parcel of land adjacent to the VA Southern Nevada Healthcare Complex, and is working through the planning process with the City of North Las Vegas.

The Tunnel to Towers Foundation has completed a full-scale conversion of a former hotel in Houston, TX, into a high-end, affordable apartment complex, which now provides permanent and transitional housing to 131 veterans in the greater Houston area. The property is equipped with a comprehensive service center, offering veterans a library of needed supportive services, provided by U.S. VETS, Phase II of our Houston Veterans Village will complement the apartment complex with approximately 14 Comfort Homes, serving as permanent housing for senior citizen veterans.
